



Emergency Evacuation Mustering & Roll Call Solution (EEMS)



Real-Time People Locator with Mobile Device Check In

When emergencies happen, you need to know who is present and who is missing in real-time. Hikvision's Emergency Evacuation Mustering & Roll Call Solution (EEMS) mitigates risk, reduces time collecting attendance data, and simplifies the emergency roll call process. Most of all, it helps to keep people safe and allows first responders to quickly find people when they are missing from the mustering location.

▶ Safety

Know who is present in your facility at all times.

▶ Operational Efficiency

Mobile device check in delivers rapid results, accelerating the collection and filtering of check in data. This provides real-time, actionable information to first responders.

▶ Rapid Response

Knowing where to look for missing people reduces response times which can help save lives.

▶ Accountability & Compliance

Meet regulatory standards for personnel evacuation accountability, including those who remain to operate essential equipment, and stay in compliance with emergency evacuation requirements.

▶ Lower Costs

Mobile devices for roll call reduce the need for hardware and improve accuracy for the mustering process. Mustering stations can be placed anywhere and are not reliant on hard wired readers, reducing deployment costs.

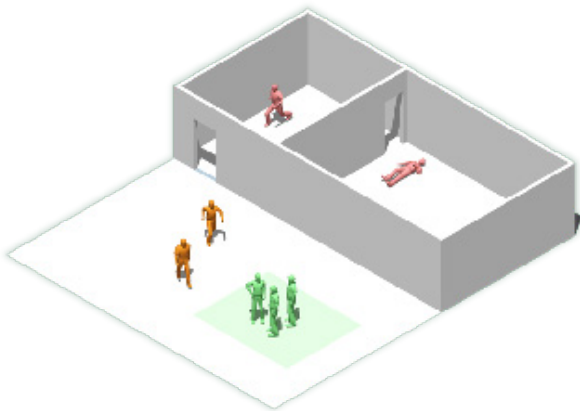
▶ Multi-Site Options

Manage independent check in at multiple sites, useful for office parks, large campuses, and multi-branch facilities.

Find People Quickly with Real-Time Data

Use Hikvision's access control system with HikCentral VMS (video management software) to facilitate accurate entrance and exit data for personnel, visitors, students, and customers. When a person leaves the building or facility, the list of who is present will be updated automatically.

When an evacuation happens, designated mustering readers or mobile devices are used for roll call check in. As people confirm they are present and accounted for, the system will register them as mustered and safe. People unaccounted for at roll call will be listed separately to facilitate locating them quickly.



How does the Hikvision EEMS work to deliver real-time safety?

▶ Emergency Alarm Triggered

An emergency event or drill may be started from a computer or mobile device with browser capabilities and access to the EEMS system via HikCentral.

▶ Personnel Accountability Checklist

The system tracks access activity for everyone including time stamps for entry, exit and muster/check in. After activation of the EEMS event the system will create a list containing:

- Those who badged in prior to the event
- Those who badged in but subsequently badged out prior to the EEMS event

▶ Roll Call Check-in

When an EEMS event begins, people start evacuating the facility. Each person will be required to check in either by mustering reader or mobile device.

▶ Accountability for Personnel

Updates are reported in real-time to administrators via computer, tablet or smartphone. This real-time data helps you determine who is inside the building(s) or on site, versus who has exited the facility/location.

▶ Take Action

Take action on missing personnel through detailed real-time reports in HikCentral Professional.
